Contests Descriptions

Descriptions:

Six Shot

- The Six Shot contest is a test of accuracy skills.
- Contestants have 6 soccer balls that they kick at the Foot Darts target.
- At the scorekeeper's direction the contestant kicks each ball at the target.
- The score is the total points made by all six shots.
- The tiebreaker is the highest individual ball scored of the highest scoring round, 2nd tiebreaker is the higher score of the first ball kicked and progresses, in order, through all balls kicked until a winner is determined.
- A trophy is awarded to the first place contestant in every age division for both girls and boys.

Speed Shot

- The Speed Shot contest is a test of kicking speed and accuracy.
- Contestants have 3 soccer balls placed directly in front of the goal and are scored by radar gun on ball speed.
- Of the 3 balls, the speed of the fastest ball kicked into the goal is the score.
- The tiebreaker is the 2nd fastest ball made.
- A trophy is awarded to the first place contestant in every age division for both girls and boys.

Summary

- Contestants may participate in both the Six Shot and Speed Shot contests alone or in both games.
